Elizabeth Lucas to Introduce New Earth-Friendly Artwork at High Point Market

Mixed-Media Print Company Returning to North Carolina with Art Pieces Created Using Reclaimed Barn Timbers

The Elizabeth Lucas Company returns for the fourth year in a row to the 2012 Fall High Point Market. Like every year previous, they're bringing new art pieces, High Point attendees being the first to see them.

This year however, they've taken 'green artwork' to another level.

Rustic Art: Using Wood Reclaimed from American Barns

In the past, ELC has used all manner of backings to create their art prints. Canvas, gauze, linens, and even recycled cardboard.

The latest medium is barnwood.

100-year-old timbers reclaimed from collapsed barns – themselves an icon of American history – are hand-milled and cut into picture-frame sizes. Then the Elizabeth Lucas paintings are printed on, creating an art piece that uses the barnwood as an element in its design.




Earth-Friendly Art and Art Materials

Since the company uses water-based inks to create these products, the new barnwood pieces are 100% earth-friendly. Two examples displayed here are "Historium" (upper right) and "Plant Life" (lower right).

Each barnwood piece, like most other ELC originals, is handcrafted. Since they are made of 100-year-old wood and display the company's "new vintage" style artwork, they make an eye-catching addition to living room walls. Pieces of Americana, given new life.
